



ACCESS TO THE CAMPSITE FOR DISABLED PEOPLE

Providing access for people with disabilities to an establishment receiving public is required by French law n° 2005-102 of the 11th February 2005. Currently, part of our installations are not entirely accessible, however, we plan on submitting an Ad'Ap program* in order to carry out the improvement as soon as possible.

Please find a list of the main equipment and their level of accessibility below.

CAR PARK

There is minimal distance between the car parking space and the main entrance (reception).

RECEPTION

The reception has one level access.

Our reception staff is informed how to welcome people with disabilities in the campsite.

BAR

The bar is entirely accessible to people with disabilities.

GROCERY SHOP

Every person with a motor disability can reach the onsite shop by its main entrance, or if in a wheelchair, by notifying his/her presence to the staff in order to access the shop from the bar (a wheelchair ramp).

RESTAURANT

The restaurant is accessible to people with disabilities.

AQUATIC AREA

The access to the aquatic area is possible by asking help of the technic staff. However, the pools are not equipped with a launching ramp.

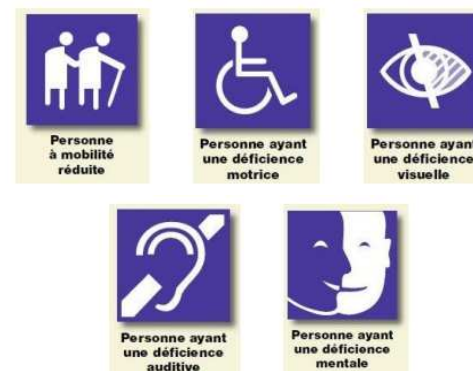
SANITARY FACILITIES

There is at least one accessible toilet and shower block close to the campsite center.

OUTSIDE PATHS

For security reasons, we recommend people with motor disabilities who want to go to the lakefront infrastructures (bar, restaurant, aquatic area, "petanque" court and sanitary facilities) to ask for help. Indeed, the natural slope between the reception and the other infrastructures are in compliance with law.

In addition, people can be dropped off at these infrastructures.



*L'Agenda d'Accessibilité Programmée is a commitment to carry out the required improvements following a deadline (3 years maximum), to finance and to respect the accessibility rules.
